Saint Maria Goretti (October 16, 1890 – July 6, 1902) is an Italian virgin-martyr, and one of the youngest canonized saints. She was born to a farming family. Her father died when she was nine, and they had to share a house with another family, the Serenellis. Maria took over household duties while her mother, brothers, and sister worked in the fields. One afternoon, Alessandro, the Serenellis' son, made unwelcome advances to her, but when she refused to submit to him, he stabbed her fourteen times. She was taken to the hospital but she died forgiving him. He was arrested, convicted, and jailed. During imprisonment he repented. After 27 years he was released from prison, and visited her mother to beg forgiveness, which she granted. He later became a lay brother in a monastery, dying peacefully in 1970. She was beatified in 1947, and canonized in 1950 by Pope Pius XII, and she is the Patron Saint of Victims of rape, Crime victims, teenage girls, modern youth, and the Children of Mary.
