The Minibus will be leaving Cardigan at 4:30pm Prompt, and will collect people from the Mart bus stop in Newcastle Emlyn at 4:55pm. We will return shortly after the Mass has finished.

## **Renovation Work is starting on the Church in Cardigan on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> July**

This means we will celebrate the last Mass in the Church in Cardigan This Sunday, and then the Church will possibly be out of use until the end of November.

Weekday Masses will be in St Ann's Room, however for the time being, there will be no adoration or any other services accompanying Mass, until we find our feet and get used to the new environment.

Sunday Masses will be celebrated in the Hall.

The Hall is hired throughout the week, but the weekends are all kept free for us to celebrate Holy Mass. We can still have our cup of tea and coffee after Mass, and the more helpers we get to set out chairs and to replace them in the store room the better. The blessed Sacrament will be brought to the Hall on Sunday Morning before Mass, and then returned to the Tabernacle in the sacristy after Mass, so there will be the opportunity to pray before the Blessed Sacrament each Sunday before Mass. The Shrine Statue will also be brought to the Hall, together with the statue of the Sacred Heart, and the stage area will become our Sanctuary.

We will carry on as normally as we can, and your patience and understanding during this time are very much appreciated. People go camping for their holidays (some people apparently choose to do this...), so let's consider ourselves as being on holiday, camping in the hall until the Church is ready for us to return.
