Renovation Work has started on the Church in Cardigan

This means the Church is out of action possibly until the end of November.

Weekday Masses are in St Ann's Room, however for the time being, there will be no adoration or any other services accompanying Mass, until we find our feet and get used to the new environment.

Sunday Masses will be celebrated in the Hall.

The Hall is hired throughout the week, but the weekends are all kept free for us to celebrate Holy Mass. We can still have our cup of tea and coffee after Mass, and the more helpers we get to set out chairs and to replace them in the store room the better. The Blessed Sacrament will be brought to the Hall on Sunday Morning before Mass, and then returned to the Tabernacle in the sacristy after Mass, so there will be the opportunity to pray before the Blessed Sacrament each Sunday before Mass. The Shrine Statue is also in the Hall, and the statue of the Sacred Heart, and the stage is now our Sanctuary. We will carry on as normally as we can, and your patience and understanding during this time are very much appreciated. People go camping for their holidays (some people apparently choose to do this...), so let's consider ourselves as being on holiday, camping in the hall until the Church is ready for us to return.

We ask the prayers of each other, and of the saints: as they, just like us, were of different backgrounds and different characters. St Alphonsus Liguori (1st August) – a bishop, philosopher, theologian and doctor of the Church is the founder of the Redemptorist Order, while St John Vianney (4th August), was nearly not ordained, because he struggled so much with his seminary studies. He later became the most famous parish priest in France attracting thousands to his confessional, and the first secular parish priest to be canonised. . This week, let us remember to pray for one another, as well as those who are most in need. Through God's grace, may we build his kingdom here and now, and show his love to others – Saints of God – Pray for us.
