Wednesday is a Holy Day of Obligation - The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary : which celebrates the Church Teaching that at the end of her earthly life, Our Lady was taken up into Heaven, to share in the life of her Divine Son – the same life we receive through the Sacrament of Baptism. It was defined on November 1st, 1950, by Pope Pius XII, who said “it is a dogma of the Church that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory.” Like Moses, Enoch and Elijah were taken into heavenly glory, Mary the Mother of Jesus – Our Blessed Lady would be the first to follow her Son into His Glory. This feast helps us celebrate the hope of the Resurrection and the life promised to us by Christ, so let us celebrate it with great joy! Foods traditionally associated with the celebration of this feast include meringue, pavlova and macarons together with other light and fluffy foods. **A happy feast day to you all !!**
