**Please Note: You can come to ANY Mass. The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy days is suspended.**

Every effort has been made to make the Church building and our attendance at Mass as safe and secure as possible. The procedures we are following are as a result of governmental guidance and the instruction of the Bishop’s conference of England and Wales, and even though it is not what we are used to in ordinary times, it is a way of providing safety and reassurance to our community of faith. Your safety and wellbeing are paramount! Please do everything that is asked of you, and be assured of a safe and protected environment.

The windows have to be open to provide for good ventilation, and unfortunately the toilets are not in use as this is part of the guidelines we must follow. Thank you for your co-operation and understanding at this time.

**The Church in Newcastle Emlyn:** will remain closed until further notice, as there is not adequate room to provide for social distancing rules needed to allow us to celebrate Mass in reasonable numbers. Please God, we will open soon.

**October – Month of the Holy Rosary:** during this month, we are encouraged to pray the Holy Rosary, and to meditate upon the mysteries of our salvation. You may already pray the rosary each day as part of your usual prayers, so maybe you could consider praying the Rosary together as a family each day. If you don’t already pray the Rosary together, you could just try starting with one decade, and build from there – try it, and see how you get on. Please remember to pray for the sick and the housebound, and those most in need of our prayers, but especially at this time of pandemic, please remember to pray for healing and health for all people, and an end to the devastating effects of this coronavirus.
