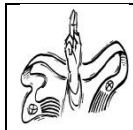

Memorial Candles: will be available at the back of the Church for £3 each (they burn for 3 days). You can place them on the graves of loved ones, *or you can place them in the basket on the sanctuary near the Lectern to burn before the Altar (In Newcastle Emlyn only).*

The Blessing of Graves: is a simple, yet very moving liturgy, where we gather to pray at the cemetery, and then the priest accompanies families to the graves of their loved ones to pray, and bless the grave with holy water. It is a tradition in many Catholic countries to light candles at the graves, or place flowers there. The blessing of graves will take place at:

Bridell Cemetery on Sunday 3rd November at 2:30pm

Cardigan Cemetery on Sunday 3rd November at 3:30pm

Newcastle Emlyn Cemetery on Thursday 7th November at 11:15am (just after the Morning Mass)

A Plenary Indulgence: is applicable to the dead, by visiting a cemetery or Church, and praying the creed & Our Father.

Pray for Henry Morgan Harris: Who will be baptised at Emlyn this Saturday evening at Mass.

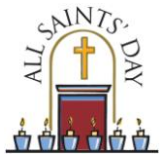
Friday 1st November – Holy day of obligation – All Saints
