Thank you. **November – Month of the Holy Souls**: During November, we pray especially for the faithful departed. The Masses in both Parishes will be offered for those who are remembered in our Dead lists. This includes those whose anniversaries occur during this month. Funeral Masses, and Masses of Obligation will be celebrated in addition to these.

<u>There are November Dead lists at the back of the Church</u>: for you to complete and return, ready for them to be placed before the Altar. <u>Please return them as soon as you can.</u>

Please write anniversaries that fall during November clearly on the back with their appropriate dates – Thank you. **Memorial Candles**: are available at the back of the Church for £3 each (they burn for 3 days). You can place them on the graves of loved ones, or you can place them in the basket on the sanctuary near the Lectern if you would like them to burn before the Altar and the November Dead lists. Please do not place them before the Altar yourself, so that they can be timed out to burn through-out the month of November – thank you.

The Blessing of Graves: is a simple, yet very moving liturgy, where we gather to pray at the cemetery, and then the priest accompanies families to the graves of their loved ones to pray, and bless the grave with holy water. It is a tradition in many Catholic countries to light candles at the graves, or place flowers there. The blessing of graves will take place at:

Newcastle Emlyn Cemetery on Wednesday 2nd November at 12 Noon (there will be Mass at 11:00am) Cardigan Cemetery on Sunday 6st November at 2:30pm.

Bridell Cemetery on Sunday 13th November at 2:30pm

(This cemetery is just past Bridell Nursing Home, where two Priests and a number of Carmelite Nuns are buried). Please consider coming along if you have loved ones buried in these cemeteries, or to pray for the faithful departed.

A Plenary Indulgence: is applicable to the dead, by visiting a cemetery or Church, and praying the creed & Our Father.

Ideas for the Christmas Fayre: If you have any ideas or suggestions, please see Sr Angela. That time is approaching!

Sacramental Preparation for Children and young people in our parishes: The candidates with the Catechists will be presented to the parish, and blessed during Mass on Sunday 20th November (the Solemnity of Christ the King – Youth Sunday).
