A Plenary Indulgence: is applicable to the dead, by visiting a cemetery or Church, and praying the creed & Our Father.

Candlelit Vigil of Prayer for the Faithful Departed: is on Thursday 23rd November at 6:30pm in Cardigan. It is a gentle and quiet time of prayer for those who have died, and for all those who grieve. There will be some short readings, a reflection and the lighting of candles as the names of the faithful departed are read out. All are very welcome, please invite friends.

Helping our loved ones with funeral preparations: during the month of November we focus our prayer on praying for the faithful departed. Losing a loved one is a very difficult and sad time, and there are many things to consider for those who have to prepare the funeral. In order to assist with this difficult process, there are purple forms at the back of the Church that can help in giving direction to family members in planning your funeral.
