The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy days is currently suspended – let us pray for each other.

During November we pray for the Faithful departed – the Holy Souls: If you would like to have your loved ones remembered in the Masses during the month of November, please complete and return them as soon as you can. THIS CAN BE DONE VIA E-MAIL (if you wish to make a donation for the Masses, this can be done at a later date).

The names will be typed up and placed before the Altar, and names will be read out at each Mass. With the COVID restrictions, this process will take a little longer than in previous years, so please return your loved ones names as soon as you can, so that they can be written up. *Please write anniversaries that fall during November clearly on the back with their appropriate dates.*

There will be a vigil of prayer for the faithful departed at the end of the Month, where all the names inscribed in our November Dead list will be read out, and we pray for the repose of their souls, and also for all who mourn their loss.

The Church in Newcastle Emlyn: will remain closed until further notice, as there is not adequate room to provide for social distancing rules needed to allow us to celebrate Mass in reasonable numbers. Please God, we will open soon.

A big thank you: to all who have helped in allowing our Church doors to open for the celebration of Mass. Without the help of our 7 volunteer stewards we would not be able to open – Diolch o galon – Hertfelt thanks!! **If you would like to volunteer to help, please speak with Fr Phillip. More volunteers means more Masses open to the public.**

This Sunday is Remembrance Sunday: as usual, we begin the Mass this weekend by keeping 2 minutes of silent prayer, as we pray for the dead of all war, and for a future blessed with peace. **There are no public services at the War Memorials in Newcastle Emlyn or Cardigan today.**
