November – Month of the Holy Souls: During November, we pray especially for the faithful departed. The Masses in both Parishes will be offered for those who are remembered in our Dead lists. This includes anniversaries during November.

There are November Dead lists at the back of the Church: for you to complete and return, ready for them to be placed before the Altar. *Please write anniversaries that fall during November clearly on the back with their appropriate dates.*

Memorial Candles: are available at the back of the Church for £3 each (they burn for 3 days). You can place them on the graves of loved ones, or you can place them in the basket on the sanctuary if you would like them to burn before the Altar.

The Blessing of Graves: The blessing of graves will take place at: **Bridell Cemetery** on Sunday 13th November at 2:30pm (This cemetery is just past Bridell Nursing Home, where a Priest and a number of Carmelite Nuns are buried).

Please consider coming along if you have loved ones buried in these cemeteries, or to pray for the faithful departed.

A Plenary Indulgence: is applicable to the dead, by visiting a cemetery or Church, and praying the creed & Our Father.

Helping our loved ones with funeral preparations: during the month of November we focus our prayer on praying for the faithful departed. Losing a loved one is a very difficult and sad time, and there are many things to consider for those who have to prepare the funeral. As many people don't discuss their wishes for their own funerals, families are often left trying to do their best to honour their loved one's wishes. In order to assist with this difficult process, there are purple forms at the back of the Church that can help in giving direction to family members in planning your funeral. Please look at this leaflet to see if it could be of benefit to your family when they have the difficult task of trying to honour your wishes through funeral preparations.

Vigil of Prayer for the Faithful Departed: is on Thursday 24th November at 6:30pm in Cardigan. It is a gentle and quiet time of prayer for those who have died, and for all those who grieve. All are very welcome, please invite friends.
