Many sincere thanks: to all who helped make our Parish Feast Day celebrations in Cardigan last Sunday a joyful and food filled event! Many came into the hall and brought tasty delights for all to share and spend time together eating and chatting – God reward your generosity! And happy Feast day!

Building update: The floor tiling continues inside, with the back of the Church already completed. The long awaited porch tiles have arrived and are ready to be put in place. The re-wiring is progressing well, with the outside wiring already in place. The lighting that is going inside and outside the Church has been carefully selected to ensure it is not only very energy efficient, but also that the bulbs (LED) will be very long lasting. The paving outside the Church is still being laid, as the ground was being levelled to the correct heights to allow surface water to drain away from the building. The cross for the top of the Church has been completed, and it looks spectacular. It will be put in place during the coming week.

Cleaning the Church after the building work has finished: is something that has to be done before the finishing touches can be made (eg – putting carpet in the sanctuary area). If people are willing and able to volunteer to help with the clean, this will mean we do not have to get a cleaning company in to do this work. It is not light cleaning, it is considerable, but not impossible. We do not yet have a date to move back in, so we hope to be able to begin the deep clean on a Saturday in the near future. If you can help, please put your name and contact details on the list in the porch, so we will know if we have enough willing volunteers to make this a possibility. Many thanks for your consideration and willingness to help.
