The Season of Easter: is celebrated until Pentecost!! Celebrate this season with joy, because it is the foundation of ALL our celebrations! Pasg Hapus i bawb – a Happy Easter to all!!!

Pentecost: We will have the Welsh National Pilgrimage to Cardigan on the Solemnity of Pentecost. Please consider how you may be able to get involved and make the pilgrims feel welcome. The gift of the Spirit is given to all of us, so that we may use our gifts for the benefit of all. The more people that volunteer, will make the greater welcome to all visitors!

The Month of May: is dedicated by the Church to our Blessed Lady, in seeking her intercession. It is a good opportunity to make extra effort to pray the Rosary daily, and to remind ourselves of the role of Mary Mother of Christians, as was proclaimed from the Cross. Please pray the rosary each day during this Month of May (it is prayed 20 minutes before Mass), and please remember in your prayers, those of our Parish who are unwell or housebound.

Ascension Thursday: is a holy day of Obligation, which means we as a Christian community are called together to celebrate the mysteries of our Lord's life by celebrating Holy Mass together. The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales had transferred many of the Holy Days to the nearest Sunday – HOWEVER, following petitions from the faithful, they have decided to move the Solemnity of the Ascension back to its original day of Thursday (40 days after Easter Sunday). There will be Mass in Newcastle Emlyn and Cardigan on Thursday – Enjoy the Feast day!!
