**The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy days is currently suspended – let us pray for each other.**

**During November we pray for the Faithful departed – the Holy Souls:** If you would like to have your loved ones remembered in the Masses during the month of November, please complete and return them as soon as you can. THIS CAN BE DONE VIA E-MAIL (if you wish to make a donation for the Masses, this can be done at a later date).

The names will be typed up and placed before the Altar, and names will be read out at each Mass. With the COVID restrictions, this process will take a little longer than in previous years, so please return your loved ones names as soon as you can, so that they can be written up. *Please write anniversaries that fall during November clearly on the back with their appropriate dates.*

There will be a vigil of prayer for the faithful departed at the end of the Month, where all the names inscribed in our November Dead list will be read out, and we pray for the repose of their souls, and also for all who mourn their loss.

**The service of Blessing of Graves:** will not take place in our parishes this year, due to the fact we are in a lockdown.

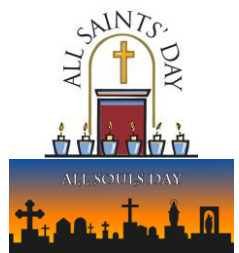
However, we are all encouraged to pray for the repose of the souls of our loved ones and all the faithful departed, and to gain the indulgence applicable to the Faithful departed by praying the Creed, the Our Father and praying for the intentions of the Holy Father. This can be done at home, and at any stage during the month of November. It could be part of our daily prayers during this month, as we join in the Mass each day, or simply spend time in prayerful reflection at some point each day.

**Security measures:** the local Police advised we should have a security system fitted to record the outside of the Church in Cardigan. This has now been installed, and the site is protected by 24hour CCTV. Any contributions towards the cost will be gratefully received.
