**Red Boxes:** If you have a Missio Red Box and you are in Cardigan Parish, please would you return them to Ann Busby for counting, as the returns are due before the 18<sup>th</sup> of December. Thank you for supporting the work of the Missions.

**Please pray for the repose of the Soul of:** Trish Norris RIP, who recently died, her body will be brought into Church on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> at 5:00pm and her Requiem Mass will be on Friday at 11:30am. May she rest in peace.

**Sacramental Preparation for Children and young people in our parishes:** The candidates with the Catechists will be presented to the parish, and blessed during Mass on Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> November (the Solemnity of Christ the King – Youth Sunday). First Holy Communion preparation – Friday 5:45pm, Confirmation – Sundays 11:45am. Please pray for them.
