The Solemnity of Corpus Christi: is a beautiful celebration of the gift of the Holy Eucharist. There will be a short procession of the Blessed Sacrament immediately at the end of Mass, ending with Benediction. The Blessed Sacrament will be processed out of the Church, down the slope towards the Hall, and back up the central path leading to the Church. Please stay and pray if you can, before going to have tea and coffee in the Hall.

The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart: although not a holy day of obligation, it is a beautiful feast of devotion to the loving heart of Jesus. The month of June is dedicated as a focus of prayer towards the Sacred Heart – the fathomless depth of love Our Lord has for us. There is adoration of the Blessed Sacrament before each weekday Mass in Cardigan, and devotions before the feast of the Sacred Heart – why not try and make the effort this month to spend some extra time in prayer before our Eucharistic Lord? May it be a time of grace for all of us!
