A woman brought him a gift of two fine wax candles to dispel the darkness of his cell, as he was being held captive before his martyrdom by Agricola, governor of Cappadocia, because St Blaise would not renounce his Christian Faith. May his prayers keep us all safe from illness of the throat – and hopefully colds and flu too!!
