**The Transfiguration of the Lord** :All three Synoptic Gospels tell the story of the Transfiguration (*Matthew 17:1-8; Mark 9:2-9; Luke 9:28-36*). With remarkable agreement, all three place the event shortly after Peter's confession of faith that Jesus is the Messiah and Jesus' first prediction of his passion and death. Peter's eagerness to erect tents or booths on the spot suggests it occurred during the week-long Jewish Feast of Booths in the fall. Peter, James, and John had a glimpse of Jesus' divinity strong enough to strike fear into their hearts. Jesus warned them that his glory and his suffering were to be inextricably connected. Tradition names Mount Tabor as the site of the revelation. A church first raised there in the fourth century was dedicated on 6<sup>th</sup> of August. A feast in honour of the Transfiguration was celebrated in the Eastern Church from about that time, and in the West from about the eighth century. A happy feast day to you all !!
